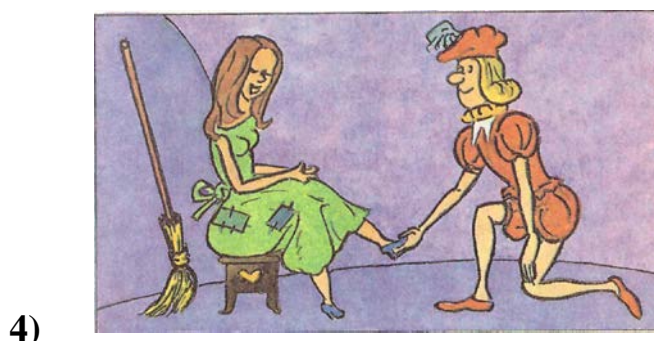

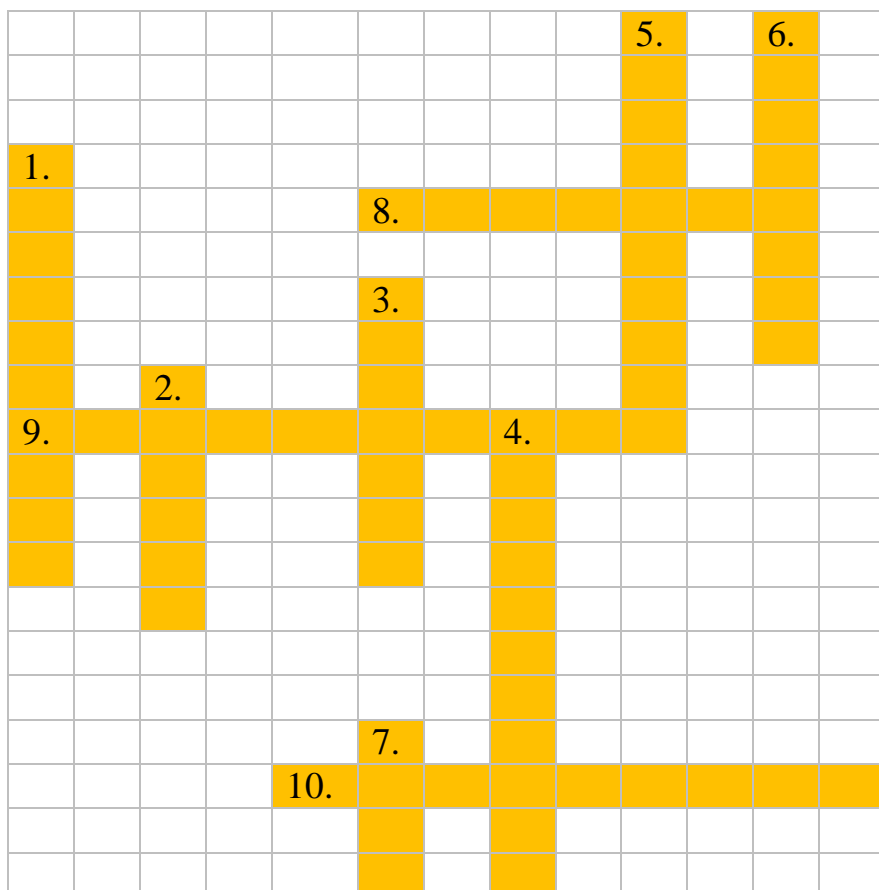

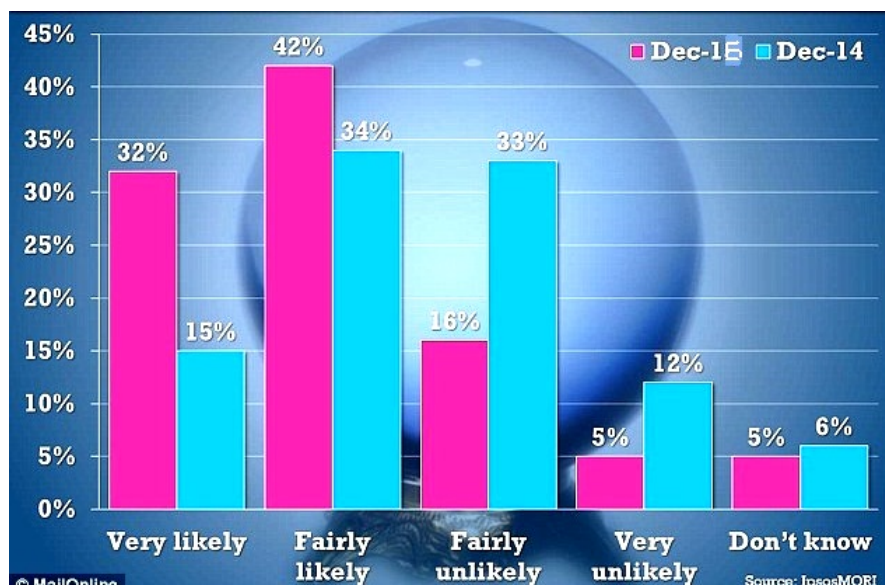

### **Who killed Martin Luther King?**

On the night of April 4th 1968, when the police came to Lorraine Motel in downtown Memphis where Martin Luther King \_\_\_\_\_ (**1. to stay**), they saw him \_\_\_\_ (**2. to lie**) on the balcony shot dead.

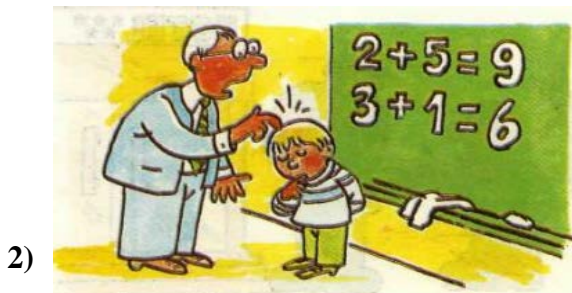
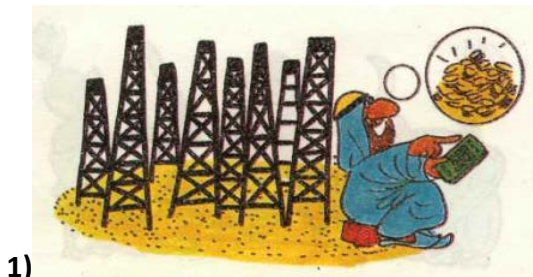

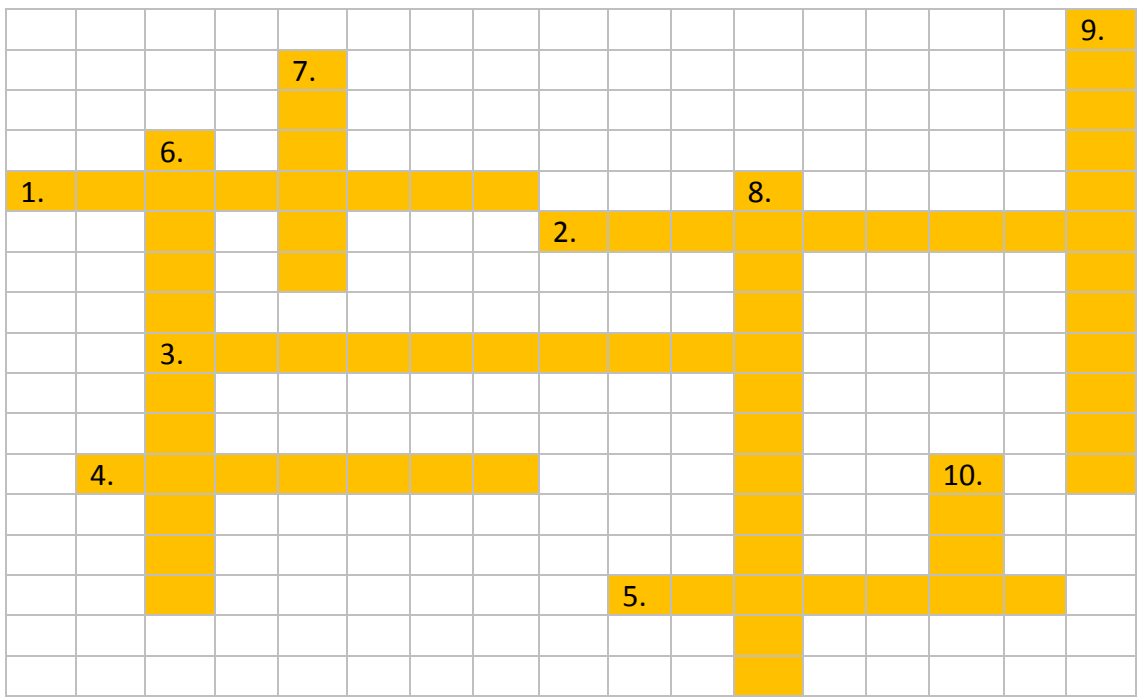

Among the three, Xan was the only one who carried a personal grudge. As a child he had seen his parents butchered by the Americans in Vietnam. From that moment he had vowed in silent torment to avenge his loss. He escaped to Japan and there, for two years he had lain low. In 1981, he obtained Japanese citizenship, a passport, and started his new career.

The others had limited roles to play in support of his operation.
