

At this time Disney created a new character. It was based on a pet mouse which he once had. Disney's wife named him Mickey. Disney put Mickey in his first film with sound, 'Steamboat Willie'. And very soon Mickey Mouse became the world's most popular cartoon character!

Following Mickey's success, Disney created other characters such as Donald Duck, Goofy, and Pluto. Dozens more cartoons followed, including Snow White, Bambi, Peter Pan, Alice in Wonderland, Cinderella, Mary Poppins and many more.


But Walt Disney Disneyland did not stop at this. He had a new idea: to create a theme park with entertainment based on his cartoons. As a result, Disneyland opened it in 1955. The park was a great success and it still is one of the most popular parks in the world. Disney also planned to build an even larger park called Walt Disney World. Today Walt Disney's films and parks are still enjoyed by millions of people each year. His company continues to produce wonderful movies and entertainment every year.
