Vincent Willem van Gogh was a Dutch Post-Impressionist painter who had a **far-reaching** influence on 20th-century art. Van Gogh drew as a child but did not paint until his late twenties, completing many of his best-known works during the last two years of his life. In just over a **decade** he produced more than 2,100 artworks, including 860 oil paintings and more than 1,300 watercolors, drawings, sketches and prints. After years of anxiety and frequent bouts of mental illness, he died aged 37 from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

Van Gogh was born to upper middle class parents and spent his early adulthood working for a firm of art dealers. He traveled between the Hague, London and Paris, after which he taught in England at Isleworth and Ramsgate. He was highly religious at this age and **aspired** to become a pastor. From 1879 he worked as a missionary in a **mining** region in Belgium where he began to sketch people from the local community. In 1885 he painted his first major work, entitled *The Potato Eaters*. In March 1886, he moved to Paris and **discovered** the French Impressionists. Later, he moved to the south of France and was influenced by the strong sunlight he found there.

Globalization is the process of international integration arising from the interchange of world views, products, ideas and other aspects of culture. **Advances** in transportation and telecommunications infrastructure, including the rise of the telegraph and its posterity the Internet, are **major** factors in globalization, generating further interdependence of economic and cultural activities.

Though scholars place the origins of globalization in modern times, others **trace** its history long before the European age of discovery and voyages to the New World. In the late 19th century and early 20th century, the connectedness of the world's economies and cultures grew very quickly.

The term globalization has been increasingly used since the mid-1980s and especially since the mid-1990s. Traditionally, the Greek philosopher Hippodamus (5th century BC) is regarded as the first town planner and 'inventor' of the orthogonal urban layout. Aristotle called him 'the father of city planning', and until well into the 20th century, he was indeed regarded as such. This is, however, only partly **justified**. The Hippodamian plan that was called after him, is an orthogonal urban layout with more or less square street blocks.
