Задание 1

News Anchor: It took India 6 months to register its first half a million coronavirus cases, but just three weeks to reach a million – a milestone it topped on Friday. So far, major cities like Delhi and Mumbai have been the worst affected. But now rural areas in the south-east and west of the country are seeing significant rises.

India went into a nation-wide lockdown in March when there were just a few hundred cases. It was lifted last month but some medics like Dr. Harjit Singh Bhatti from Delhi's Manipal Hospital say that was a big mistake.

Dr. Harjit Singh Bhatti: The reopening of lockdown is also a major cause for it because first thing is that the lockdown period was not used appropriately for breaking the chain of transmission, and secondly the lockdown was reopened without any further planning to how to control the virus.

News Anchor: Well, other people point to areas of progress. Dr. Harsh Mahajan is Vice President of the National Federation of Healthcare in India.

Dr. Harsh Mahajan: There are some silver linings also – Delhi and Mumbai – the numbers are coming down. And in fact only 25% of COVID beds are now occupied. India has had very good case fatality rate – (that) it's been 2.5%. If you look at the US or Brazil it's 3.9 and 3.8%.

News Anchor: But our correspondent in Delhi Zubair Ahmed says that if you look at the rate of spread, the figures are very worrying.

Zubair Ahmed: Every day the rise in cases breaks the previous day's record, with reports of cases coming from new areas, from smaller towns and cities. So that is where they are spreading now.”
