Hartley was a good actor although the calls on his talents were now infrequent. But really, he thought draining his awful coffee, he'd had a reasonably good career. Something to be proud of. But he'd never had that break-through part.

“Cutting it a bit fine,” he said.

“Indeed,” Hartley replied.

So in situations like this he simply selected an occupation from a former role. Bit risky, of course. You say you’re a doctor and find yourself meeting the quizzical gaze of a heart surgeon. But he’d never been caught out and it was a harmless enough game, Hartley felt. (30) It amused him, and he’d given some damn good performances too.

“I’m a lawyer,” he replied. “Retired several years ago. Conveyance, property law. Bit of criminal stuff.”

My senses needed to readjust themselves to firm land, to the wind and to the **discreet** sounds of night drawing in.

The restaurant was brightly illuminated and exaggeratedly warm. Large photographs of coffee cups, pastries and hamburgers hung on the walls. (10) A waitress was refilling a drinks dispenser. I slid a damp tray along a metal runway, bought a bar of chocolate and an orange juice and sat by a window that made up one wall of the building. Vast panes were held in place by strips of beige putty, into whose chewy clamminess I was tempted to dig my nails. Beyond the window, the grass sloped down to the motorway, where traffic ran in silent, elegant symmetry along six lanes, the differences in makes and colours of cars disguised by the gathering darkness, leaving a uniform ribbon of red and white diamonds extending into infinity in two directions.

There were few other customers in the service station. (15) A woman was **idly** rotating a teabag in a cup. A man and two small girls were eating hamburgers. A bearded elderly man was doing a crossword. No one was talking. There was an air of reflection, of sadness, too—only heightened by the faint sound of piped upbeat music and the enamel smile of a woman about to bite into a bacon sandwich in a photograph above the counter. (20) In the middle of the room, hanging from the ceiling and dancing nervously in the breeze of an air vent, was a cardboard box announcing an offer of free onion rings with every hot dog. **Misshapen** and upside down, the box seemed only a rough approximation of what head office must have

stipulated, like those milestones in distant parts of the Roman Empire whose form strayed from the designs of the centre.

The building was architecturally miserable, it smelt of frying oil and lemon-scented floor polish, the food was **glutinous** and the tables were dotted with islands of dried ketchup from the meals of long-departed travellers, yet something about the scene moved me. There was poetry in this **forsaken** service station perched on the ridge of the motorway, far from all habitation. (24) Its appeal made me think of certain other equally and unexpectedly poetic travelling places—airport terminals, harbours, train stations and motels—and the work of a nineteenth-century writer and a twentieth-century painter he inspired, who were, in their different ways, unusually alive to the power of the liminal travelling place.

"Well, I do not know what on earth is to be done with Camilla Clark," said Miss Bailey, with a **prodigious** sigh. "I suppose that we will simply have to trust the whole matter to Providence."

(10) Miss Bailey's tone and sigh really seemed to intimate to the world at large that Providence was a last resort and a very **dubious** one.

The case of Camilla Clark was agitating the Ladies' Aid of one of the Lindsay churches. They had talked about it through the whole of that afternoon session while they sewed for their missionary box—talked about it, and came to no conclusion.

In the preceding spring James Clark, one of the hands in the lumber mill at Lindsay, had been killed in an accident. The shock had proved nearly fatal to his young wife: the next day Camilla Clark's baby was born dead, and the poor mother hovered for weeks between life and death. (15) Very slowly, life won the battle, and Camilla came back from the valley of the shadow. But she was still an invalid, and would be so for a long time.

The Clarks had come to Lindsay only a short time before the accident. They were boarding at Mrs. Barry's when it happened, and Mrs. Barry had shown every kindness and consideration to the unhappy young widow.

But now the Barrys were very soon to leave Lindsay for the West, and the question was, what was to be done with Camilla Clark? (20) She could not go west; she could not even work; she had no relatives or friends; and she was absolutely **penniless**. As she and her husband had joined the church to which the aforesaid Ladies' Aid belonged, its members felt themselves bound to take up her case.

The obvious solution was for some of them to offer her a home until she could work. But there was no one who could do this – unless it was Mrs. Falconer.

The church was small, and the Ladies' Aid smaller. (25) There were only twelve members in it; four of these were unmarried ladies who boarded; seven had large families, or sick husbands, or something else that prevented them from offering Camilla an asylum. Their excuses were all valid. However, it was probable they would eventually manage it in some way if Mrs. Falconer did not rise to the occasion.

Nobody liked to ask Mrs. Falconer outright to take Camilla Clark in, yet everyone thought she might offer. She was comfortably off, and though her house was small, there was nobody to live in it except herself and her husband. (30) But Mrs. Falconer sat silent through all the discussion of the Ladies' Aid, despite the numerous hints which she received.

Miss Bailey made one more effort. When her despairing reference to Providence brought forth no results, she wished she dared ask Mrs. Falconer openly to take Camilla Clark, but somehow she did not dare as she was daunted by Mrs. Falconer's reserve and gentle aloofness.

When Miss Bailey had gone, Mrs. Falconer paused for a few moments at her gate, apparently lost in deep thought. She was perfectly well aware of all the hints that had been thrown out for her benefit that afternoon. (35) But she had no room to give Camilla – for it was out of the question to think of putting her in Missy's room.

"I couldn't do such a thing," she said to herself piteously. " I'm sorry for poor Camilla, and I wish I could help her. But I can't give her Missy's room, and I have no other."
