

As the time got closer and closer, the visions of wandering around Paris like a character out of Ernest Hemingway's *A Moveable Feast* or a Jean-Luc Godard film had gone away, replaced by a mix of nerves and anxiety. I **ultimately** decided not to study abroad for a year and it was a conclusion I almost immediately **regret**ted.

Ever since that **fateful** week spent in my <u>shoebox-sized dorm room</u> playing games of 'Fifa 10' and watching obscure art-house films to impress people, I made a promise to myself. If I ever got even the chance to take part in a similar exchange abroad, I would <u>grasp</u> it <u>with both hands</u>. Eight long years later, I have finally realised my 19-year-old's ambition to work in Europe, with a teaching position in Luebeck, Germany. Throughout that time, having completed my MA degree in 2016, I went from job to job in England, not being particularly happy in any one position. In those times it felt as if things would never really change.

The advice I would give to any young person who is perhaps overthinking whether or not to work or study abroad is to just do it! Unfortunately our lives aren't rehearsals and, even though I was lucky enough to get a second chance, opportunities to travel, explore and embrace the world can be few and far between. The number of new friends, exposure to different cultures, and new experiences I have already got in just one month in Germany have been incredible and have made an **impact** on my life. Don't be like me, mournfully watching *Amélie* whilst staring into the Manchester rain. Go and live the adventurous life you dream about.



However, the <u>dependable sunshine</u> and heat in this city draw my attention to the lack (or sheer non-existence) of changing seasons. <u>A beautiful cycle</u> which once to me seemed so ordinary and mundane.

With the festive season soon approaching, I can't deny that I'm longing to be wrapped up on a crisp autumn day just as I was this time last year. I recently found this longing of mine perfectly illustrated through a poem written by Rupi Kaur which she titled 'Unappreciative'. The poem uses the seasons as a metaphor for essentially always wanting what you don't have. I'm pretty certain that if I was still sitting in my university library in Scotland right now, I'd be wishful of a life in Colombia, which for so long was my dream. And now here I am, longing to see familiar piles of leaves dyed burgundy and amber just as I know there are back home.

Having the luxury of experiencing life in two completely different parts of the world <u>leaves room for comparison</u>, and feelings which could be considered 'unappreciative'. Along with these feelings also comes the need to accept that as much as you love one thing, there will always be parts of you that long for something else. After all, being able to appreciate the value of something which is now absent will only make you more appreciative when it returns.

Now, whenever England is playing a big match, <u>red and white adorns every inch of every bar</u>, a symbol of hope: the English flag.

Football has never been something I have been particularly interested in. For years, I have had to **feign** excitement, and <u>pick a team or risk ridicule</u>. You cannot say you don't like or do not follow football in England, as often this would lead to a long dialogue in which someone would begin telling you why you should support their team. Growing up in north London, I quickly learned everyone around me supported Arsenal, and so <u>I blindly did the same</u>, for fear of having the same conversation more than fifty times.

Often, I feel **annoyed** when everyone around me is brimming with excitement over two groups of people kicking a ball in a field. However, I understand the culture, and I enjoy the excitement. When I was younger and football was inescapable in physical education lessons or the playground, I would always pick the same position to play in a football match: goal defence. I feel similarly about it now. While I may not ultimately desire to play the sport or take part in supporting the teams, I will nevertheless **defend** people's obsession with the sport. It is their history and obsession.
