(1) Giannis Bellonias was standing on the edge of a craggy cliffside in Imerovigli, a village built on the apex of Santorini's vertigo-inducing caldera, waiting for sunset from the infamous lookout known as the 'balcony to the Aegean'.

(2) "There, right there! (3) Look at the volcano," the Santorini local said to me, pointing to what are in fact two small, black lava islands created by volcanic activity (and are the most recently formed pieces of land in the Eastern Mediterranean basin), called Palea Kameni (Old Burnt) and Nea Kameni (Young Burnt).

(4) With sun-bleached, blue-shuttered houses dotted among rocks, and alabaster paved paths meandering between them, Santorini is the archetypal Greek island fantasy, an envy-inducing sight on travel brochures and Instagram posts. (5) But beneath the glittering facade, there is a dark secret to its seductive prowess.

(6) Situated in the southern Aegean Sea, Santorini is a small, circular group of five Cycladic islands, made up of main island Thera; Therasia and Aspronisi at the periphery; and the two lava islands. (7) All five surround a colossal, mostly drowned caldera, a bowl-shaped crater that forms when the mouth of a volcano collapses. (8) But during the Bronze Age, approximately 5,000 years ago, Santorini was a single volcanic landmass called Stronghyle (which means 'round' in Greek), and one that played a crucial role in shaping history.

(9) Around that time, a civilization started developing on the nearby island of Crete. (10) The inhabitants were the Minoans, named for mythical King Minos, an enigmatic and educated people, who were warriors but also merchants, artists and seafarers. (11) The Minoans' ancestry has been the subject of hot dispute: some believe they were refugees from Egypt's Nile Delta, while others say they hailed from ancient Palestine, Syria or North Mesopotamia. (12) The most recent research says the Minoan civilization was a local development, originated by early farmers who lived in Greece and south-western Anatolia. (13) Whatever the case, there is little doubt that between 2600 and 1100BC a sublimely sophisticated and advanced civilization thrived here. (14) Excavations in Crete, especially in Knossos (the capital of Minoan Crete), have unearthed the remains of a spectacular palace, golden jewellery and elegant frescoes.

(1) Does rushing to meet work deadlines before a break leave you more prone to coming down with an illness?

(2) I've lost count of the number of people who have told me how they rushed to get everything done in the run-up to their holiday, only to be struck down with a stinking cold the moment they stopped work. (3) It doesn't need to be during wintertime: summer holidays, beach trips and short breaks can all fall foul of a post-work health slump too.

(4) There's even a name for this affliction – leisure sickness. (5) Ad Vingerhoets, the Dutch psychologist who came up with the name, concedes this diagnosis is not yet established in the medical literature; nevertheless, the idea that you fall ill as soon as you stop work is one which many will recognise from bitter experience.

(6) There's been no large systematic study to find out whether people are more likely to fall ill when on holiday than during everyday life. (7) But to try to put some figures on it, Vingerhoets asked more than 1,800 people whether they thought they suffered from leisure sickness. (8) Just over 3% of people said they did. (9) Considering how likely we are to feel stressed and work extra-hard before a holiday, this suggests it's not the norm and even quite unusual – especially because this study relied on asking people to judge for themselves whether it happened, and we're more likely to remember a holiday ruined by an illness, than all the ones unblemished by a cold. (10) We don't remark on it when we go on holiday and feel fine.

(11) But if a small percentage of people are convinced they experience this, is there a physiological explanation? (12) Almost half the people in Vingerhoets' study put it down to the transition from work to holiday.

(13) The first theory why this might be the case goes that when we finally get the chance to relax, the stress hormones that help us cope with work deadlines get out of balance, and leave us open to infection. (14) Adrenaline helps us to cope with stress, as well as boosting the immune system to help fight infections. (15) Along with it comes cortisol which also helps with the stress, but at a cost to the immune system.
