Some scientists have studied sleep in fish that live in caves where it is always dark. Even in some of these species there are times of low activity that look just like sleep. Of course (2) in caves so their rhythm is often different to fish that live at the surface in bright sunshine. Some fish, like tuna and some sharks, have to swim all the time so that they can breathe. It's likely that these fish sleep with half their brain at a time, just like dolphins. Parrot fish make a mucus cocoon around themselves at night? (3) which might protect them from parasites attacking them while they sleep. One wonders if fish dream while they are sleeping. So far we don't have the answer to that question but recent video footage of a sleeping octopus	10
